












OVERVIEW

VEFAC was appointed by the Vietnamese Government as the developer and operator of the new National Exhibition and Convention Center Project, which covers a site of 300 hectare in Xuan Canh commune, Dong Anh District, Ha Noi, Viet Nam. This development is aimed at promoting the economic and cultural development of Hanoi and Vietnam, and integration into the world's community.

The primary component of the Project is a National Convention Center with a gross floor area of c. 120,000sqm. The project also includes other embition centers and an outdoor exhibition area, commercial areas, office buildings, residential properties, hotels and entertainment areas. The new National Exhibition and Convention Center will boast an integrated, modern and seamless design and world construction standards, worthy of a premier cultural and exhibition center, as well as a city landmark are units destination. The new National Exhibition and Convention Center has been under construction since October 2016 and is scheduled to complete in 2018.

The Center will include indoor and outdoor exhibition areas, a trade promotion center, a conference hall, a 52-story five-star hotel and a financial hub. Only 20 minutes from Hanoi CBD, at the junction of Xuan Canh, Mai Lam, and Dong Hoi Communes in Dong Anh District, the Center is expected to become an 'exhibition city' in the future.





LOCATION

The National Exhibition and Convention Center is part of a mixed-use urban project in Dong Hoi and Xuan Canh Commune, Dong Anh District, Ha Noi. The Project covers a c. 300ha site and lies on both side of the National Highway No. 5, just 1.5km away from Dong Tru Bridge.

The new National Exhibition and Convention Center is highly accessible. The Project is located on one of the main routes connecting Ha Noi city center and Noi Bai International Airport, 15 minutes from the airport and 20 minutes to the city center. The site is also located at the junction of various national highways which allows it to be easily connected to main ports and bordergates such as:

- Hai Phong (120km 1h30min) via Hanoi Hai Phong Express way. Hai Phong is the primary gateway of Vietnam for sea transportation. The largest seaport of the North of Vietnam, Dinh Vu port, is located in the city.
- Quang Ninh (190km 3h30min) via Hanoi Hai Phong Express way and national highway no. 10. Quang Ninh is an important tourist destination in the north with the famous world heritage, Ha Long Bay. Mong Cai border gate, an important border gate between Vietnam and China, is also in Quang Ninh.
- Lang Son (170km 3h30min) via National highway no. 1. Lang Son is an important province of the north with the busy Dong Dang bordergate connecting Vietnam and Guangxi, China.




FIGURE 2 PROPOSED METRO LINE CONNECTING THE PROJECT TO HANOI CITY CENTER

Infrastructure in the adjacent areas is being developed extensively. Most notably, the Hanoi People's Committee has approved zoning for a metro line running through the site and a station at the new National Exhibition and Convention Center, bringing even more connectivity between the site and other urban areas in Ha Noi.

COMPREHENSIVE DESIGN PROGRAMME AND FUNCTIONALITY

The National Exhibition and Convention Center is the primary component of a mixed-use urban project development. The project covers a site of c. 300ha with four main components:



NATIONAL EXHIBITION AND CONVENTION CENTER:

Consists of 9 exhibition, convention, multi-function halls with an aggregate GFA of 120,000sqm. There are two other exhibition centers with a total GFA of 220,000sqm and another 220,000sqm of outdoor exhibition area.



LOW-RISE RESIDENTIAL

Villas and low-rise townhouses will cover a total area of c. 773,000 sqm with a total GFA of c. 1,392,000 sqm.



MIXED-USE COMMERCIAL:

Commercial components include a shopping mall, high-end hotels, offices, SOHO offices and luxury residential properties. These components will be located next to the Exhibition Center to provide necessary amenities.



SUPPORTING FACILITIES:

Other facilities include kindergarten, primary, middle- and highschool.






One of the fastest growing economies in the region⁽¹⁾ 2015 real GDP growth (%)




The third most populous country in Southeast Asia⁽²⁾



Inflation and interest rates are well managed(3)




Disbursed FDI consistently on the rise(4)




e rise⁽⁴⁾ Positive trends in consumer confidence⁽⁵⁾

POSITIVE OUTLOOK OF THE EXHIBITION INDUSTRY

- The exhibition industry supports the economic growth of Vietnam. Hanoi and Ho Chi Minh City, being the largest cities in the country, are the key hubs for exhibition shows and congresses of various kinds in Vietnam.
